Find the range of meaning of the word in Paul, and then decide who is Paul referring to in this passage. Be sure to decide on the gender of this particular group. Now do the

same thing in James in the NIV2011. There is one verse that should really stand out. Why do you think the translators translated this verse this way?

4. Find the range of παρακαλέω and παράγγελλω, and then decide the best translation of the words throughout 1 Timothy, especially at 1 Tim 1:3 and of παράγγελλω at 6:13.

5. Do one of the following word studies.
 - a. σάρξ in Galatians
 - b. "World" in the gospel of John
 - c. "Perfect" (1 Cor 13:9-10)
 - d. παράκλητος
