1. Mark 1:9

2. Matt 12:27

3. John 19:28

After this, Jesus, knowing that all things had already been accomplished, to fulfill the Scripture, said, "I am thirsty" (NASB).

4. Rev 1:8

“I am the Alpha and the Omega,” says the Lord God,

Almighty.”

5. 1 Thess 5:3

While people are saying, “Peace and safety,” destruction will
come on them suddenly (NIV).

When they say, “Peace and security,” then sudden
destruction will come upon them (CSB).

6. Acts 7:54

When they heard these things, they became furious and
ground their teeth at him (NET).

When they heard these things, they were enraged and
gnashed their teeth at him (CSB).

7. Matt 7:7

Ask and it will be given to you, seek and you will find,
knock and it will be opened for you.

8. Rom 6:17

But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became obedient from the heart.

9. Rom 1:8

First of all, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being proclaimed throughout the whole world.
